In response to the Coronavirus crisis, we are taking steps to ensure the health and safety of coworkers, customers and community during this challenging time. We want The Farm Store to remain a haven of peace and replenishment, and for you to feel welcome and cared for when you visit our establishment. To this end, we have implemented simple but effective measures to protect you and our team.

- 1) CALL IT IN** – Effective immediately, we are accepting phone orders from anyone who prefers to not come in the store. Call in your grocery list, we'll put it together for you and bring it out to your car.
- 2) PAYMENT BY PHONE** – Effective immediately, we are accepting credit card payment by phone for pick-up orders. As mentioned above, we will bring items to your car if you prefer to not come in.
- 3) AVOID CASH** – During this time, we highly encourage Credit Card, Debit Card and contactless payment. Avoid cash if possible.
- 4) SANITATION** – We do not have the ability to provide public self-serve sanitizer, but we are constantly going through every area of the shop and building to disinfect high touch areas.
- 5) FOOD & BEVERAGE SERVICE** - Everything will be served in to-go containers. No mugs, utensils or plates will be given out, even if eating in.
- 6) COFFEE TO GO** – No self-serve and no personal travel mug for now. Coffee to go will be served in disposable cups from behind the counter.
- 7) EVENTS, CLASSES & DEMOS** – We will resume classes and demos when the crisis has passed.
- 8) PLEASE STAY HOME IF YOU ARE FEELING ILL** - We LOVE our customers and community and want you to be and stay well, but as much as we will miss those of you who choose to stay away from public places at this time, we understand and ask that you please stay home if sick... and get well soon!

These new policies are in effect until further notice. We will be monitoring local and national health authorities' recommendations and requirements and adjusting our practices accordingly.
